## **Your PTA Can Vote to Support YES Votes on the PVUSD Bond & DAA Override**

Step 1: At your next **PTA meeting** explain PTA advocacy. Arizona PTA encourages PTAs statewide to get involved with ballot issues pertaining to children. PTAs must remain nonpartisan but are encouraged to advocate for or against bills that relate to fully funding and prioritizing Arizona's public schools.

Step 2: Discuss the [PVUSD Bond and DAA Override Election](#) and/or have a Yes! For PV Students representative come speak to your group by emailing [yesforpvstudents@gmail.com](mailto:yesforpvstudents@gmail.com)

Step 3: Vote to support a YES vote on the PVUSD Bond and a YES vote on the DAA Override. Supporting Yes Votes on both the Bond and DAA Override relates to children and supports PTA's advocacy for funding Arizona's public schools.
